Description

After years of practice, many nurses begin to ask 'what's next for me?'

Developing practice-based questions can be a rejuvenating way to engage differently in one's career. This session will introduce a self-assessment of readiness and resources to guide nurses' engagement in scholarly activity, and planning for practical projects.
