



Buprenorphine – A First Line Consideration for Pain Management in Serious Illness Registration Form

In this 3-hour hybrid interactive course, clinicians caring for people with serious illness will learn about the different formulations of buprenorphine used for pain management as well as for opioid use disorder. Clinicians will apply their knowledge about the pharmacology of buprenorphine to discuss applications for use in the hospital, ambulatory and end-of-life care settings through the use of interactive case-based discussions.

Learning Objectives:

At the conclusion of this activity, learners will be able to:

- Discuss the unique pharmacologic properties of buprenorphine, including the use of various formulations, indications and contraindications to treat pain.
- Identify patients that may benefit from the use of buprenorphine.
- Implement strategies to increase confidence in prescribing and managing buprenorphine therapeutic regimens across care settings.
