**Waiver and Release for Participation in
 Wilderness First Aid Course for Nurses and EMTs**

I, _____, acknowledge and agree that I wish to voluntarily participate in the Wilderness First Aid Course (the “Course”) for Nurses and EMTs being offered through the Departments of Emergency Medicine and Continuing Nurse Education at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Clinic and Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital, operating jointly and referred to herein as “Dartmouth Hitchcock”. I understand that my participation in the Course is completely voluntary and that the Course fee is \$75.00 (Dartmouth Hitchcock and Clinics) or \$100 (Member Organizations) for two days of participation (September 30, from 7:30 am – 5:00 pm, and October 1, 2022, from 7:30 am – 4:00 pm). I will receive nursing continuing education credits or a certificate of participation for this Course 15.0. Part of the Course will involve participation in mock rescue exercises, and I will be going to **The Class of ’66 Cabin, Etna, NH** (the “Class of ’66 Cabin”) with my instructors and fellow students for this portion of the Course’s training and education.

The Class of ’66 Cabin is located in a forested area with hiking trails. The Class of ’66 Cabin is a “use at your own risk” area and is not on Dartmouth-Hitchcock property, nor is it maintained by Dartmouth-Hitchcock. The cabin where the learning activity takes place is about a 15-minute walk from the parking area, and is off the grid, with minimal solar power and an outhouse for bathroom facilities. By signing this waiver, I agree to comply with all rules and restrictions for use of the Class of ’66 Cabin.

I understand that travel to and from the Class of ’66 Cabin and parking of my personal vehicle or other mode of transportation to and from the Class of ’66 Cabin as well as those activities and exercises I participate in while at the Class of ’66 Cabin or the Course could carry the risk of potentially serious injuries or illness, loss or damage to personal property, or financial loss or theft as a result of my participation. I agree to voluntarily assume the full risk of any and all injury, damage and loss of any kind arising out of my participation in these voluntary activities and the Course. I am solely responsible for my own personal belongings while attending the Course and using and traveling to and from the Class of ’66 Cabin.

In signing this waiver, I, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and personal representatives, release and forever discharge Dartmouth Hitchcock its affiliates, subsidiaries, and related entities and any and all of their directors, officers, employees, agents assigns, successors, representatives, and insurers from any and all risks or injuries, damages, harm, or financial losses that occur to me as a result of my voluntary participation in the Course and related activities at he Class of ’66 Cabin, whether or not the liability, loss or damage is caused in whole or in part by the negligence or gross negligence of Dartmouth-Hitchcock, their affiliates, subsidiaries, or related entities, or each of its or their directors, officers, agents, employees, assigns, successors, or representatives or their failure to use reasonable care.
