Human Trafficking: A Focus on Pediatric Patients

DESCRIPTION

Dr. Wendy Gladstone, a retired child abuse pediatrician, and Darlene Pawlik, a survivor of adolescent trafficking, will discuss the approach to the patient when trafficking is a concern. Topics covered will include red flags, screening, health care needs of patients, involvement of child protection and law enforcement, and the multidisciplinary approach to care. This program is being offered by the Department of Pediatrics and the DHMC Task Force on Trafficking, Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault.
